

3. Have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.5.
4. Submit a high school transcript or GED score (Official transcripts are accepted)
5. Demonstrate in strong community involvement

Dr. Kendra S. Robison Servant Leadership-Educational Opportunity Center Student

1. Application must have participated in at least one TRIO/EOC activity held by the Community Outreach Coalition.
